## **Main Hall**

Opened in 1986 and built on the concept of “in pursuit of the world’s most beautiful sound”, the Main Hall of Suntory Hall was designed in the vineyard style, the first of its type in Japan, in which the stage is surrounded by the audience. Come to Suntory Hall to enjoy the rich acoustics in what Herbert von Karajan praised as “a jewelry box of sound.”
